# Ongoing Business: Shawna Orton

- Used Book Fair Results Lindsey and Amanda K. We raised roughly \$1,100 for the library. WOOHOO!
- Calendar Sales Results Alicia Awesome We sold 56 calendars, which means the school received \$560. Thank you, Vaz Art! Pick-up is scheduled for Friday, November 29. Alicia will handle the pick-up day
- Hot Lunch Update

- Labels are back in action
- At Exec discussion, decision was made to poll parents regarding new sushi lunch option. Jana and Katlyn will get this going. Price point will be higher than other lunch offerings, but supplier would handle organizing/labeling
- Continue slow roll-out for The Fig to make sure it grabs hold before making a permanent option.
- Also talking to BPs for other lunch options
- Amanda R. shared some information about what options other schools are using for hot lunches.
- Christmas Flowers Fundraiser Shawna Order will be going in tomorrow.
- Christmas Basket Raffle Update Decided to move toward an online option and sell tickets via the hot lunch site. There would be 2-3 baskets of each theme.

  Trish/Marnee in the process of finding out details for selling online and what gaming license would be required. Amanda K. pointed out that this fundraiser may need to be cancelled due to too short of a time window

### **New Business: Shawna Orton**

- Set Date for school-wide Christmas Treat Day
  - o Trish will contact the organizing teachers for the Christmas week regarding plans for the week. *We propose Tuesday, December 17. We need to check the school calendar to make sure that date works.*
- Deanna Michaud attended on behalf of the Grade 7 Grad Committee. She spoke on behalf of another grad committee parent regarding setting up a Raffle Box account under the PAC, and Whitney would be willing to be the PAC representative for future use of the Raffle Box. The PAC will look into whether this would create any complexities/complications with our Gaming Grant.
  - Question #2 is regarding setting up a bank account for the grad committee. Katrina said the grad committee could potentially transfer the money through the PAC bank account. *Katrina to look into a potential option that would work best (possibly being a "collection point" for funds, then writing a cheque for the lump sum)*
- Lindsey suggests the school hosting an Artisan Market like Alexis Park and other schools. Theirs included a 50/50, PAC concession, raffle, silent auction, and every vendor paid \$40 for their table (approx 30 vendors in attendance)
- Teach and Learn has posted about shopping nights for individual schools, and this would raise funds as a store credit for the school. Shawna will ask Trish if she has had any communication with the store.
